



Teacher's Feedback regarding Curriculum Response Collected: 62











Suggestions by Teachers regarding curriculum

- 1. Syllabus should be updated.
- 2. Syllabus should be expanded and topics should be in sequence and correlating to former one.
- 3. Innovative techniques using ICT for teaching and learning should be opted.
- 4. Syllabus should be continuously modified in a manner that it could lead to fulfilment of required skills of present industrial demand.
- 5. Modification in education system was required but policies should be continuously modified so as to overcome the Challenges regarding NEP 2020.

Analysis of Feedback Provided by Teachers

- 1. While over 70% of teachers believe that the syllabus is thorough, they also believe that the curriculum should be updated to reflect current demands
- 2. Although 80% of teachers are happy with current internal assessment procedures, they also believe that new approaches to internal assessment should be used.
- 3. Most of the teachers are satisfied with the availability of resources/ books/journals for academic enrichment of students.
- 4. Majority of teachers believe that they are continuously enhancing their skills so as to incorporate modern technology in teaching methodologies.
- 5. Teachers agree that the ratio of teachers to students needs to be addressed.
